Image of Received Coral

The left image below shows the coral placed in the tank, after dipping. As you can see, the coral has spikes protruding completely, which is essentially how the coral dies. At no point has this improved. The right image below is the coral that I purchased as part of the “What You See Is What You Get” order. This means that the coral in the bottom right picture is the exact coral that I purchased, no “general pictures” of the coral. The color is similar, however you can see there are clearly not white skeletal spikes protruding from the flesh.



Image of Coral Today (8/7/2021)

The image below shows the coral today. As you can see, the coral is dying due to the tissue damage from the skeletal punctures. The mouth in both pictures (day received, and today) both show the mouth gaping open, and the coral is losing color dramatically.
